What is YOUFIN?

YOUFIN is an Erasmus+ project focused on financial empowerment, supporting young migrants and refugees (16–30) to develop financial literacy and digital skills, strengthening their autonomy and social inclusion. The project is implemented in Portugal, Belgium and Spain.

Main Objectives

To develop a youth-friendly, culturally adapted Financial Literacy Toolkit; build digital financial skills (mobile banking, apps, online safety and scam awareness); train youth peer mentors with lived experience; and foster partnerships with youth organisations, banks and public services to promote inclusion through non-formal youth work.

Why it matters?

Financial literacy is essential for autonomy, empowering young people to manage their finances confidently and make informed decisions. It reduces vulnerability to financial exploitation, supports long-term integration, and bridges the gap between youth work and financial education through accessible, non-formal learning.g approaches.

Main Results

Over 90 young migrants and refugees trained across three countries, 15 youth peer mentors prepared to facilitate learning, a multilingual modular Financial Literacy Toolkit, an open-access Peer Mentoring Guide, local stakeholder events, and a youth-friendly website with digital materials to ensure wider impact and replication.
